<b>EVENT'S CONCEPT</b>	<p>Provides NFs/ NOCs with an additional opportunity to clinch qualification berths for the 2016 Olympic Games, apart from the Continental Beach Volleyball Cup Final and Olympic Ranking.</p> <p>Played by the 2nd and 3rd ranked countries from each Continental Beach Volleyball Cup Final, this tournament will qualify 2 places per gender to the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio de Janeiro, BRAZIL.</p>

It is strongly recommended to all potential participants to apply for the Russian Entry visa well in advance, possibly **before the start of the respective Continental Cup Finals (20-26 June 2016).**

**COMPETITION  
SCHEDULE AND  
FORMAT**

- **FIVB reserves the right to slightly adjust the competition format by the 27<sup>th</sup> June 2016 when issuing a Version 2 of the Event's Regulations. However, this will not affect the competition dates.**
- Round Robin Competition (Pool play) with Country vs. Country match-ups with "the best 2 out of 3 matches"(2 matches and a golden set –if needed)
  - First two matches are best of 3 to 21, 21 and 15 points (Normal beach volleyball)
  - If the first two matches are tied 1-1 then a golden set is played to 15 points to determine the match-up winner
  - Example Country vs. Country Match-up:
- The 1<sup>st</sup> ranked countries from each pools will advance directly to the Finals, while the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> ranked countries will play the quarterfinals before playing against the 1<sup>st</sup> ranked countries from the pools to determine the quota places to Beach Volleyball tournament at Rio 2016 Olympic Games.
- 3 competition courts on 4 competition days and 1 competition court on the last day
  - Competition schedule template (e.g. A1 vs A4, A2 vs A5...etc.) is published before the Technical Meeting
  - Round Robin (Pool play) –July 6 to July 9
  - Quarterfinals – July 9 / July 10 (depending on # of participating NFs)
    - 2<sup>nd</sup> ranked Pool A vs. 3<sup>rd</sup> ranked Pool B;
    - 3<sup>rd</sup> ranked Pool A vs. 2<sup>nd</sup> ranked Pool B;
  - Finals (Olympic Qualification Match-ups)-July 10
    - 1<sup>st</sup> ranked Pool B vs. winner of match-up between 2<sup>nd</sup> ranked Pool A vs. 3<sup>rd</sup> ranked Pool B;
    - 1<sup>st</sup> ranked Pool A vs. winner of match-up between 3<sup>rd</sup> ranked Pool A vs. 2<sup>nd</sup> ranked Pool B.
- Team 1 and Team 2 for each country are confirmed to the FIVB Technical Supervisor and the FIVB Referee Delegate during the preliminary Inquiry. The team with higher FIVB Entry Points (as of the day of the Preliminary Inquiry of the tournament) shall be Team 1 for that NF. In case both teams have the same entry points, the NF must declare Team 1 and Team 2 at the preliminary inquiry by the NF representative (Team manager or Head Coach, etc.) Immediately after the Preliminary Inquiry, the list of Team 1 and Team 2 designations for each participating country will be published at the Technical Meeting and they can't change during the competition. Any paring of players among the 4 players can complete in the golden set.
- 10/12 countries per gender
  - 12 countries per gender if Russia is not qualified directly its 2 quotas per gender through the Olympic ranking or Beach Volleyball Continental Cup (CEV Finals);
  - As per the results of drawing of lots held during the 2015 FIVB Beach Commission Meeting on October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015, should there be 12 countries participating the World Continental Cup Olympic Qualification in Sochi, the 12<sup>th</sup> place is granted to the country from the CEV for both, Men and Women tournaments.
- 2 pools of 5 or 6 countries
  - Pools are created by random draw during the Technical Meeting. Since the competition schedule template is published before the Technical Meeting, the creation of the pools will determine the competition schedule (Which country plays which country on what date and time) and it will set the seeding for the tournament:

- Countries from the same Continental Confederation will be in different pools
  - 2 pools of 5 – Each Pool will has one country from AVC, CAVB, CEV, CSV and NORCECA
  - 2 pools of 6 –Each pool will have one country from AVC, CAVB, CEV, CSV, NORCECA and either Host (Russia) or CEV (4<sup>th</sup> place)

<p><b>ALTERNATE COUTRIES TO ENTER THE 2016 OLYMPIC GAMES</b></p>	<p>Within 30 minutes following the completion of the each competition (Both women and men), a draw will be conducted at the venue to determine which of the two countries that were defeated in the final two match-ups at the 2016 FIVB BVB WCCOQ will be the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> alternate country for the 2016 OG. This draw will be carried out by the FIVB Technical Supervisor and possibly be attended by a representative of the two delegations concerned, the event's promoter, the hosting NF and other officials. Should one or both of the countries that earned a berth to the 2016 RIO Olympics at the 2016 FIVB BVB WCCOQ be unable to compete in the 2016 RIO Olympics, they will be replaced by the alternate countries with the 1<sup>st</sup> alternate countries filling the 1<sup>st</sup> vacancy and 2<sup>nd</sup> alternate filling a 2<sup>nd</sup> vacancy.</p>
<p><b>GOLDEN SET</b></p>	<p>If the Golden set is to be played in case of a tie, the formally announced Head of Delegation at the Preliminary Inquiry (the Head of Delegation can be an NF Representative or an athlete, etc.) shall announce and confirm to the FIVB Technical Supervisor within 5 min from the end of the second match the composition of the team to play the Golden Set. Otherwise, Team 1 of the country concerned who failed to confirm the team composition in due time, will play the Golden Set.</p>
<p><b>ATHLETES PARTICIPATION RESTRICTIONS/ ELIGIBILITY</b></p>	<p>Athletes having qualified an Olympic place for its country through the Olympic ranking (established on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2016), cannot take part to the FIVB Beach Volleyball World Continental Cup Olympic Qualification:  <b>Men:</b> <a href="http://www.fivb.org/EN/BeachVolleyball/OGRanking_M.asp">http://www.fivb.org/EN/BeachVolleyball/OGRanking_M.asp</a>.  <b>Women:</b> <a href="http://www.fivb.org/EN/BeachVolleyball/OGRanking_W.asp">http://www.fivb.org/EN/BeachVolleyball/OGRanking_W.asp</a>.</p> <p><b>IMPORTANT:</b> NFs/ NOCs having qualified an Olympic place will have to submit by the Entry by Name the representing athletes/ teams respecting the minimum athlete Olympic eligibility requirements:</p> <p>To be eligible to qualify through the Continental Cup or FIVB World Continental Cup Olympic Qualification, athletes must have at least <b>12 participations</b> as an individual in <b>Continental Cup, National and/or Continental and/or FIVB events</b> scheduled from 1 May 2014 until 10 July 2016.</p> <p>To verify the athlete Olympic eligibility status of the athletes nominated by the NOCs/ NFs having gained an Olympic place through the Continental Cup or FIVB World Continental Cup Olympic Qualification will submit to the FIVB <b>by the 15 July 2016, the Athlete Olympic Eligibility form (attached).</b></p>



<b>ENTRY (FIVB WEBSITE)</b>	<p>Countries gain entry to the event by ranking either 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> place at their Continental Cup Final (AVC, CAVB, CEV, CSV and NORCECA). Should the Host country (Russia) not qualify directly then Russia will be awarded a host berth and the 4<sup>th</sup> place team from the CEV (as per the draw conducted at the 2015 FIVB Beach Volleyball Commission Meeting on October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015) will also gain entry into the event.</p> <p>The final confirmed team entry list will be issued on <b>Monday, 27<sup>th</sup> June 2016</b>.</p>

<b>PRELIMINARY INQUIRY AND TECHNICAL MEETING</b>	<p>All Athletes must attend the mandatory <b>Preliminary Inquiry from 17:00-19:00 July 5</b> at the hotel SportInn (Conference hall).</p> <p>Team 1 and Team 2 for each country are confirmed, by each countries head of delegation, to the FIVB Technical Supervisor and the FIVB Referee Delegate during the preliminary Inquiry. At the start of the Technical Meeting (Before the draw to create the pools) the Team 1 and Team 2 designations for each participating country will be published and they can't change during the competition. Any paring of players among the 4 players can compete in the golden set.</p> <p>All Athletes must attend the mandatory <b>Technical Meeting at 20:00 July 5</b> at the hotel SportInn (Conference hall).</p> <p>A random drawing of lots will be conducted during the Technical Meeting and this will determine the composition of the pools, the event schedule and seeding of the teams.</p>																																			
<b>UNIFORMS AND ACCESSORIES</b>	<p>Athlete uniforms shall be provided by the FIVB/ Organiser onsite, and the athlete uniform regulations shall apply as per the 2016 FIVB Beach Volleyball Sports Regulations. The principle of uniform distribution will be announced at the Technical Meeting.</p> <p>If required by the FIVB Technical Supervisor, uniforms and accessories will be checked during the Preliminary Inquiry. Athletes of the same team must wear the same color and style of shorts. The display of the individual players' sponsors' logos on shorts and accessories must comply with the FIVB advertising regulations. While tank tops will be provided by the Organizers to the athletes, shorts/bottoms and accessories must be provided by the players and/or by their sponsors.</p>
